12 STATEMENT OF FACT

13 This bill appropriates \$25,000 in each year of
14 the biennium for the Department of Educational and
15 Cultural Services to contract with a person or firm
16 to develop school-based child care programs for care
17 before and after regular school hours. The person or
18 firm shall work with and provide technical assistance
19 to local school units in setting up the programs.

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
