5 6	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
7	38 MRSA §350 is enacted to read:
8	§350. Prior supervisory employees
9	Within 2 years of leaving employment as a super-
10	visory employee in the department, no person may en-
11	gage in any activity, which is licensed or regulated
12	by the department, for financial gain.

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The purpose of this bill is to prohibit former supervisory employees in the Department of Environmental Protection from engaging in activities licensed by the Department of Environmental Protection for a period of 2 years after leaving that employment.

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
