9	B. The following are exceptions concerning subsection 17.
.1 .2 .3	(1) Paragraphs A, B, C, D, E and F do not apply to military organizations authorized by law to bear arms or to the National Guard in the performance of its duty.

The commissioner may impose limitations or conditions on the applicant through the special permit. To qualify for a permit the applicant must:

20	(b) Have lost one or more hands;
21 22 23 24	(c) Appear before the commissioner or his designee to confirm his physical disability and demonstrate his ability to safely use a crossbow; and
25	(d) Hold a valid hunting license.

This bill allows certain disabled persons to hunt with a crossbow during the hunting season.
