

L.D. 1224 1 2 (Filing No. H-261) 3 STATE OF MAINE 4 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 113TH LEGISLATURE 5 6 FIRST REGULAR SESSION COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " H " 7 to H.P. 912, L.D. 1224, Bill, "AN ACT to Ban the Use of Plastic Connec-8 9 tors for Containers." 10 Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title 11 and inserting in its place the following: 12 'AN ACT to Ban the Use of Nondegradable Plastic 13 Connectors for Containers." 14 Further amend the Bill in section 2 by striking 15 out all of the first paragraph after the amending 16 clause (page 2, lines 1 to 4 in L.D.) and inserting 17 in its place the following: 'No person may sell, or offer for sale, contain-ers connected to each other by a separate holding de-vice constructed of plastic rings or other plastic bolding device unless this device decomposes by 18 19 20 holding device, unless this device decomposes photodegradation, chemical degradation 21 by 22 or 23 biodegradation within a reasonable period of time 24 upon exposure to the elements. 25 Further amend the Bill in section 3 in the first 26 line after the amending clause (page 2 line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: " of plastic 27 ring carriers" and inserting in its place the follow-28 29 ing: 'of nondegradable plastic carriers' 30 Further amend the Bill in section 4 by striking 31 out all of subsection 2 and inserting in its place 32 the following: 33 Connectors. 1 vice, which does not decompose by photodegradation, 2 chemical degradation or biodegradation within a reasonable period of time upon exposure to the ele-3 4 ments.' 5 Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end 6 before the statement of fact the following: 7 'Sec. 5. Effective date. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 1988.' 8 9 STATEMENT OF FACT 10 The original bill prohibited the use of plastic in devices used to connect containers sold as a 11 multipack, of which soft drinks and beer are the best 12 examples. This amendment allows the use of plastic connecting devices if the plastic is degradable by 13 14 15 any of several means.
