COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 915, L.D. 1227, Bill, "AN ACT to Create a Statewide Reservation System for State Parks that have Overnight Camping Facilities."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
