

4 5	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
6 7	Sec. 1. P&SL 1969, c. 91, §1 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
8	Sec. 1. Territorial limits; corporate name and
9	purpose. The inhabitants of the territory of the
.0	Town of Harrison in the County of Cumberland, except
.1 .2 .3	for that area served by the Bolsters Mills Water Dis-
.2	trict, and that part of the Town of Bridgton, more
.3	commonly known as North Bridgton, in the County of
.4	Cumberland, as is described: All that part of the
.5	towns which lies north of North Latitude 44° -04'-
.6	00" and east of West Longitude 70-43'-00" as shown on

- the United States Army Corps of Engineers 15 minute series topographic map entitled "Norway, Me." shall be and are constituted a body politic and corporate under the name of the "Harrison Water District" for the purpose of supplying the district and the inhabitants of the district with pure water for domestic, commercial, sanitary, industrial, agricultural and municipal purposes.
 - The authority granted under this charter to serve that part of the Town of Bridgton described in this chapter, shall supersede the authority granted the Bridgton Water District to serve that area.

- Sec. 2. P&SL 1969, c. 91, §7, first 3 paragraphs are repealed and the following enacted in their place:
- Sec. 7. Trustees; how elected; meetings; officers. All of the affairs of that district shall be managed by a board of trustees composed of 5 members, all of whom shall be residents of the district, as provided for, and elected as provided for in this section. Trustees shall service for 3-year terms.
 - The candidates for office shall obtain nomination papers from the clerk of the Town of Harrison, who is appointed especially to act as clerk in this particular instance. The form of the nomination papers, and the form of the ballot, shall be as provided. The only eligibility for the office of trustee of the district shall be residents within the district, and eligibility to vote, and trustees shall be elected as provided in an annual election to be held on the 3rd Monday of March in each year.
 - Sec. 3. P&SL 1969, c. 91, §7, next to the last paragraph, last sentence is amended to read:
- 34 Each trustee shall receive for his services in what-35 ever capacity, compensation as determined by said the 36 board, but said the compensation shall not exceed 37 \$200 \$400 per annum.

Sec. 4. P&SL 1969, c. 91, §§10 and 11 are repealed.

Sec. 5. P&SL 1969, c. 91, §16, as amended by P&SL 1969, c. 214, is repealed.
