STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Concerning the Harrison
Water District.

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4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 Sec. 1. P&SL 1969, c. 91, §1 is repealed and the
7 following enacted in its place:

8 Sec. 1. Territorial limits; corporate name and
9 purpose. The inhabitants of the territory of the
10 Town of Harrison in the County of Cumberland, except
11 for that area served by the Bolsters Mills Water Dis-
12 trict, and that part of the Town of Bridgton, more
13 commonly known as North Bridgton, in the County of
14 Cumberland, as is described: All that part of the
15 towns which lies north of North Latitude 44° -04'-
16 00" and east of West Longitude 70-43'-00" as shown on

1 the United States Army Corps of Engineers 15 minute
2 series topographic map entitled "Norway, Me." shall
3 be and are constituted a body politic and corporate
4 under the name of the "Harrison Water District" for
5 the purpose of supplying the district and the inhabi-
6 tants of the district with pure water for domestic,
7 commercial, sanitary, industrial, agricultural and
8 municipal purposes.

9 The authority granted under this charter to serve
10 that part of the Town of Bridgton described in this
11 chapter, shall supersede the authority granted the
12 Bridgton Water District to serve that area.

13 Sec. 2. P&SL 1969, c. 91, §7, first 3 paragraphs
14 are repealed and the following enacted in their
15 place:

16 Sec. 7. Trustees; how elected; meetings; offi-
17 cers. All of the affairs of that district shall be
18 managed by a board of trustees composed of 5 members,
19 all of whom shall be residents of the district, as
20 provided for, and elected as provided for in this
21 section. Trustees shall service for 3-year terms.

22 The candidates for office shall obtain nomination
23 papers from the clerk of the Town of Harrison, who is
24 appointed especially to act as clerk in this particu-
25 lar instance. The form of the nomination papers, and
26 the form of the ballot, shall be as provided. The
27 only eligibility for the office of trustee of the
28 district shall be residents within the district, and
29 eligibility to vote, and trustees shall be elected as
30 provided in an annual election to be held on the 3rd
31 Monday of March in each year.

32 Sec. 3. P&SL 1969, c. 91, §7, next to the last
33 paragraph, last sentence is amended to read:

34 Each trustee shall receive for his services in what-
35 ever capacity, compensation as determined by said the
36 board, but said the compensation shall not exceed
37 \$200 \$400 per annum.

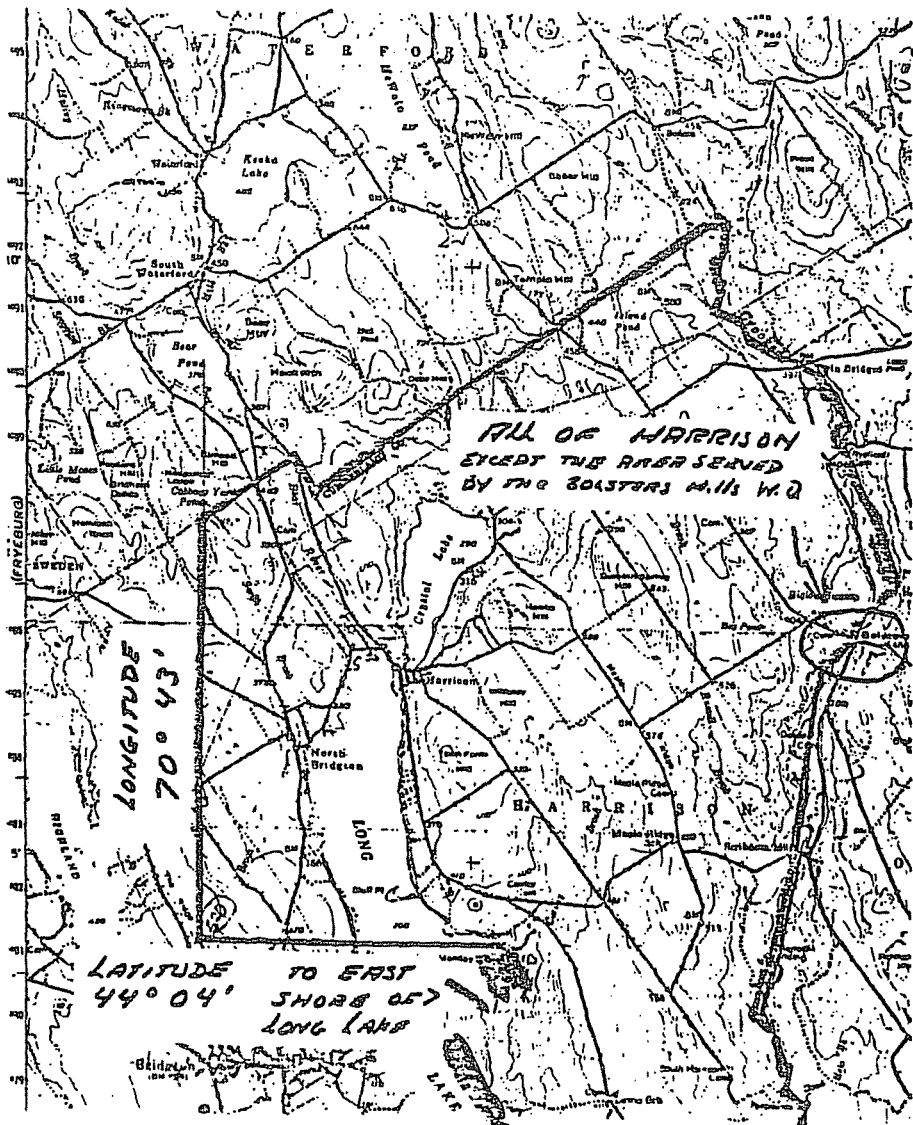
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Sec. 4. P&SL 1969, c. 91, §§10 and 11 are re-
pealed.

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Sec. 5. P&SL 1969, c. 91, §16, as amended by
P&SL 1969, c. 214, is repealed.
