1 AN ACT to Modify the Definition of Sexually 2 Explicit Conduct. 3 4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows: 6 17 MRSA §2921, sub-§5, ¶¶E and F, as enacted by 7 PL 1977, c. 628, §1, are amended to read: 8 E. Lewd exhibition of the genitals, anus or 9 pubic area of a person; or 10 F. Conduct that creates the appearance of the 11 acts in paragraphs A through D and also exhibits 12 anv uncovered or covered portions of the 13 genitals, anus or pubic area.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill is intended to do 2 things. First, as to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 17, section 2 3 2921, subsection 5, paragraphs E and F, it adds the 4 term "anus," a body part which, particularly in view of the definition of "sexual act," should be express-ly included. Second, the bill is designed to prevent 5 6 7 persons from posing children in explicit poses with 8 small pieces of clothing covering the child's pubic region or sexual or anal parts, thereby circumventing the application of Title 17, section 2921, subsection 9 10 11 12 5, paragraph F.

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
