1 AN ACT to Increase the State's Personal
2 Income Tax Exemption for Dependants.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 36 MRSA §5126, as amended by PL 1983, I.B. 2, §3
7 and as enacted by PL 1983, c. 3, §3, is repealed and
8 the following enacted in its place:

9 §5126. Personal exemptions

10 A resident individual shall be allowed an exemp-
11 tion of \$3,500 for each exemption to which he is en-
12 titled for the taxable year for federal income tax
13 purposes.

14 The nominal dollar amounts of this section are
15 subject to annual adjustment under section 5403.

The purpose of this bill is to increase the personal exemption for resident individuals under the state income tax to \$3,500.
