15 16 specifications, the commissioner may shall cause an inspection of the project to be made. The commissioner shall notify the building committee of the findings of the investigation and of any changes required. The building committee shall make the changes within a reasonable period of time. Failure to do so shall render the school administrative unit liable to the penalties provided in section 6801.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

Presently, new school construction and renovation 10 11 plans must be approved by the Bureau of Public 12 provements which requires compliance with American National Standards Institute accessibility standards, 13 the construction or renovation must be certified by 14 15 the school administrative unit to be in compliance with the plans and the commissioner may inspect and 16 compel compliance on projects which do not conform to the plans. Nevertheless, it appears that some con-17 18 struction is occurring which is not in compliance 19 20 with appropriate accessibility standards.

- To allow interested citizens to petition for a review of projects when noncompliance is suspected; and
- 25 2. To require the commissioner to conduct a re-26 view when he or she has been petitioned to do so or 27 has reason to believe the project is not in compli-28 ance.
