#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Clarify the Law Regarding Forfeiture of Property which Constitutes the Proceeds of Criminal Enterprise.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §5803, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 679, is amended to read:

In the case of any asset decreed forfeit under this chapter or-under-Title-227-section-23877 to any legal entity other than the General Fund, transfer of

legal entity other than the General Fund, transfer of title to the asset shall not occur until the transfer is approved by:

Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §2387, as amended by PL 1985, c.
737, Pt. B, §19, is repealed.
