**AN ACT to Clarify the Law Regarding
Forfeiture of Property which
Constitutes the Proceeds of Criminal
Enterprise.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §5803, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 679, is amended to read:

In the case of any asset decreed forfeit under this chapter ~~or under Title 22, section 2387~~, to any legal entity other than the General Fund, transfer of title to the asset shall not occur until the transfer is approved by:

Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §2387, as amended by PL 1985, c. 737, Pt. B, §19, is repealed.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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With the enactment of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 15, chapter 515, by the 112th Legislature concerning forfeiture of assets, Title 22, section 2387, which concerns forfeiture of all property used in delivery of illegal drugs, is no longer necessary.

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
