COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 415, L.D.
1273, Bill, "AN ACT to Maintain Lifeguard Services in
State Government."

Amend the bill by inserting after the title the
following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after ad-
journment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Bureau of Parks and Recreation is
preparing for the summer season and is in the process
of hiring lifeguards; and

Whereas, it is important that current training
programs for lifeguards be in compliance with the
guidelines issued by the United States Lifesaving As-
sociation; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore, '

Further amend the bill, in section 3, in subsec-
tion 1, in the first line (page 2, line 15 in L.D.)
by striking out the word "permanent" and inserting in
its place the word 'part-time'

Further amend the bill by adding before the
statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect

1 when approved.'

2 STATEMENT OF FACT

3 This amendment creates a part-time lifeguard co-
4 ordinating position within the Bureau of Parks and
5 Recreation to coordinate lifeguard services and
6 training. In addition, this amendment provides that
7 the coordinating position will be effective for the
8 1987 summer season.
