7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 415, L.D. 8 1273, Bill, "AN ACT to Maintain Lifeguard Services in 9 State Government."

10 Amend the bill by inserting after the title the 11 following:

12 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-13 lature do no become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

15 Whereas, the Bureau of Parks and Recreation is 16 preparing for the summer season and is in the process 17 of hiring lifeguards; and

18 Whereas, it is important that current training 19 programs for lifeguards be in compliance with the 20 guidelines issued by the United States Lifesaving As-21 sociation; and

22 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 23 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 24 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 25 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-26 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 27 therefore,'

Further amend the bill, in section 3, in subsection 1, in the first line (page 2, line 15 in L.D.) by striking out the word "permanent" and inserting in its place the word 'part-time'

32 Further amend the bill by adding before the 33 statement of fact the following:

34 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency 35 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect
