1 final disposal site is selected, without the approval  
2 of the affected tribe. Certain land is designated as  
3 potential territory for both tribes in the Maine Re-  
4 vised Statutes, Title 30, section 6205, subsection 1,  
5 paragraph B, and subsection 2, paragraph B. If a  
6 waste disposal facility is proposed on land which is  
7 potential territory for both tribes, the approval of  
8 both tribes is required.
