STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Extend the Boundaries of the Presque Isle Sewer District and the Presque Isle Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

7 Sec. 1. P&SL 1937, c. 80, \$4, as amended by P&SL 8 1963, c. 67, is repealed and the following enacted 9 in its place:

10 Sec. 4. Territorial limits; name; purposes; plans of system to be submitted to Public Utilities 11 Commission for approval. That part of the 12 City of 13 and the inhabitants within the same, Presque Isle, which is bounded and described as follows: 14 Commenc-15 ing at a point on the south line of that part of the City of said Presque Isle which was formerly the Town 16

1 2	of Maysville, and which will hereinafter be referred
	to as Maysville, which point is the northwest corner
3 4	of lot number 5, in said Presque Isle; thence easter-
	ly by said south line of said Maysville to the south-
5	east corner of section numbered 3, in said Maysville;
6	thence northerly by east line of section numbered 3,
7	in said Maysville, to the intersection of said east
8	line with the center line of the Fort Fairfield road
9	as it is now located; thence westerly by said Fort
10	Fairfield road, to a point where the same strikes the
11	old road running to the farm formerly owned by George
12	A. Parsons and now owned or occupied by Alice Kim-
13	ball, said road not now being used by the public and
14	a portion of same having at one time been occupied by
15	the Aroostook Valley Railroad Company as a right-
16	of-way; thence northwesterly by said old road running
17	to the so-called George A. Parsons farm to the inter-
18	section of said road with the north line of section
19	numbered 3 in Maysville; thence westerly along the
20	north lines of sections numbered 3, 2 and 1, in said
21	Maysville, to the northwest corner of lot numbered 1,
22	in section numbered 1, in said Maysville; thence
23	southerly by the west line of said lot numbered 1 to
24	the south line of said Maysville; thence southerly
25	from the last mentioned point, in a straight line, to
26	the northwest corner of lot numbered 83 in said
27	Presque Isle; thence southerly by the west line of
28	said lot numbered 83 to a point from which a line
29	drawn at right angles to said west line of said lot
30	numbered 83 will strike the southwest corner of lot
31	numbered 27 in said Presque Isle; thence easterly, in
32	a straight line, to the said southwest corner of lot
33	numbered 27, in said Presque Isle; thence easterly by
34	said south line of said lot numbered 27 to the south-
35	west corner of lot numbered 26, in said Presque Isle;
36	thence northerly along the west line of said lot num-
37	bered 26 to the south line of lot numbered 15, in
38 ″	said Presque Isle; thence easterly by the south line
39	of said lot numbered 15 to the southwest corner of
40	lot numbered 14, in said Presque Isle; thence north-
41	erly by the west line of lots numbered 14 and 5, in
42	said Presque Isle, to the south line of said
43	Maysville and the place of beginning; said lot num-
44	bers and section numbers being according to the orig-
45	inal surveys of that part of Presque Isle which was
46 47	formerly Maysville and of said Presque Isle, made and returned to the state land office; and in addition,
47	recurned to the state rand Orrice; and in addition,

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the following area located in said Presque Isle, namely: Commencing at a granite monument, being the southeast corner of the Town of Mapleton and the northeast corner of the Town of Chapman; thence pro-ceeding in a southerly direction along the east line of the Town of Chapman (also being the west line of the City of Presque Isle) to its intersection with a true east-west line said line being "Y" coordinate one million twenty seven thousand (1,027,000) on the Maine Transverse Mercator System (East Zone); thence proceeding easterly along said "Y" coordinate line to its intersection with a true north-south said line line being "X" coordinate six hundred thirty-two thousand (632,000) on the Maine Transverse Mercator System (East Zone); thence proceeding northerly along said "X" coordinate line to its intersection with the high water line on the south side of the Aroostook River; thence proceeding in a westerly direction along the high water line on the south side of the Aroostook River to its intersection with the east line of the Town of Mapleton; thence proceeding southerly along said east line of the Town of to the southeast corner of the Town of Mapleton Mapleton and the place of beginning; is hereby created a body politic and corporate by the name of Presque Isle Sewer District for the purpose of providing in said district a system of public sewerage and drainage for the comfort, convenience and health of the inhabitants of said district, with all the rights, privileges and immunities incident to similar corporations.

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Provided, however, that it shall not construct any system of drainage or sewerage, without first having submitted its plans to the Public Utilities Commission, and obtained its approval therefor in writing, under power vested in the commission by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35, section 13.
