STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

1 **AN ACT to Extend the Boundaries of the**
2 **Presque Isle Sewer District and the**
3 **Presque Isle Water District.**
4

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 **Sec. 1. P&SL 1937, c. 80, §4, as amended by P&SL**
8 **1963, c. 67, is repealed and the following enacted**
9 **in its place:**

10 Sec. 4. Territorial limits; name; purposes;
11 plans of system to be submitted to Public Utilities
12 Commission for approval. That part of the City of
13 Presque Isle, and the inhabitants within the same,
14 which is bounded and described as follows: Commenc-
15 ing at a point on the south line of that part of the
16 City of said Presque Isle which was formerly the Town

1 of Maysville, and which will hereinafter be referred
2 to as Maysville, which point is the northwest corner
3 of lot number 5, in said Presque Isle; thence easterly
4 by said south line of said Maysville to the south-
5 east corner of section numbered 3, in said Maysville;
6 thence northerly by east line of section numbered 3,
7 in said Maysville, to the intersection of said east
8 line with the center line of the Fort Fairfield road
9 as it is now located; thence westerly by said Fort
10 Fairfield road, to a point where the same strikes the
11 old road running to the farm formerly owned by George
12 A. Parsons and now owned or occupied by Alice Kim-
13 ball, said road not now being used by the public and
14 a portion of same having at one time been occupied by
15 the Aroostook Valley Railroad Company as a right-
16 of-way; thence northwesterly by said old road running
17 to the so-called George A. Parsons farm to the inter-
18 section of said road with the north line of section
19 numbered 3 in Maysville; thence westerly along the
20 north lines of sections numbered 3, 2 and 1, in said
21 Maysville, to the northwest corner of lot numbered 1,
22 in section numbered 1, in said Maysville; thence
23 southerly by the west line of said lot numbered 1 to
24 the south line of said Maysville; thence southerly
25 from the last mentioned point, in a straight line, to
26 the northwest corner of lot numbered 83 in said
27 Presque Isle; thence southerly by the west line of
28 said lot numbered 83 to a point from which a line
29 drawn at right angles to said west line of said lot
30 numbered 83 will strike the southwest corner of lot
31 numbered 27 in said Presque Isle; thence easterly, in
32 a straight line, to the said southwest corner of lot
33 numbered 27, in said Presque Isle; thence easterly by
34 said south line of said lot numbered 27 to the south-
35 west corner of lot numbered 26, in said Presque Isle;
36 thence northerly along the west line of said lot num-
37 bered 26 to the south line of lot numbered 15, in
38 said Presque Isle; thence easterly by the south line
39 of said lot numbered 15 to the southwest corner of
40 lot numbered 14, in said Presque Isle; thence north-
41 erly by the west line of lots numbered 14 and 5, in
42 said Presque Isle, to the south line of said
43 Maysville and the place of beginning; said lot num-
44 bers and section numbers being according to the orig-
45 inal surveys of that part of Presque Isle which was
46 formerly Maysville and of said Presque Isle, made and
47 returned to the state land office; and in addition,

1 the following area located in said Presque Isle,
2 namely: Commencing at a granite monument, being the
3 southeast corner of the Town of Mapleton and the
4 northeast corner of the Town of Chapman; thence pro-
5 ceeding in a southerly direction along the east line
6 of the Town of Chapman (also being the west line of
7 the City of Presque Isle) to its intersection with a
8 true east-west line said line being "Y" coordinate
9 one million twenty seven thousand (1,027,000) on the
10 Maine Transverse Mercator System (East Zone); thence
11 proceeding easterly along said "Y" coordinate line to
12 its intersection with a true north-south line said
13 line being "X" coordinate six hundred thirty-two
14 thousand (632,000) on the Maine Transverse Mercator
15 System (East Zone); thence proceeding northerly along
16 said "X" coordinate line to its intersection with the
17 high water line on the south side of the Aroostook
18 River; thence proceeding in a westerly direction
19 along the high water line on the south side of the
20 Aroostook River to its intersection with the east
21 line of the Town of Mapleton; thence proceeding
22 southerly along said east line of the Town of
23 Mapleton to the southeast corner of the Town of
24 Mapleton and the place of beginning; is hereby cre-
25 ated a body politic and corporate by the name of
26 Presque Isle Sewer District for the purpose of provi-
27 ding in said district a system of public sewerage
28 and drainage for the comfort, convenience and health
29 of the inhabitants of said district, with all the
30 rights, privileges and immunities incident to similar
31 corporations.

32 Provided, however, that it shall not construct
33 any system of drainage or sewerage, without first
34 having submitted its plans to the Public Utilities
35 Commission, and obtained its approval therefor in
36 writing, under power vested in the commission by the
37 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35, section 13.

38 Sec. 2. P&SL 1941, c. 67, §1, 3rd ¶, as emended
39 by PL 1963, c. 50, §1, is repealed and the following
40 enacted in its place:

41 Commencing at a granite monument, being the
42 southeast corner of the Town of Mapleton and the
43 northeast corner of the Town of Chapman; thence pro-
44 ceeding in a southerly direction along the east line

1 of the Town of Chapman (also being the west line of
2 the City of Presque Isle) to its intersection with a
3 true east-west line said line being "Y" coordinate
4 one million, twenty-seven thousand (1,027,000) on the
5 Maine Transverse Mercator System (East Zone); thence
6 proceeding easterly along said "Y" coordinate line to
7 its intersection with a true north-south line said
8 line being "X" coordinate six hundred thirty-two
9 thousands (632,000) on the Maine Transverse Mercator
10 System (East Zone); thence proceeding northerly along
11 said "X" coordinate line to its intersection with the
12 high water line on the south side of the Aroostook
13 River; thence proceeding in a westerly direction
14 along the high water line on the south side of the
15 Aroostook River to its intersection with the east
16 line of the Town of Mapleton; thence proceeding
17 southerly along said east line of the Town of
18 Mapleton to the southeast corner of the Town of
19 Mapleton and the place of beginning; are hereby cre-
20 ated a body politic and corporate by the name of
21 Presque Isle Water District for the purpose of sup-
22 plying the inhabitants of said district with pure wa-
23 ter for domestic, sanitary, commercial and municipal
24 purposes.

25 STATEMENT OF FACT

26 The purpose of this bill is to extend the terri-
27 torial limits of the Presque Isle Sewer District and
28 Presque Isle Water District.
