AN ACT to Allow the Employment of Part-time
Superintendents of Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

20-A MRSA §1055, sub-§8, as amended by PL 1983,
c. 806, §12, is repealed and the following enacted in
its place:

8. Full-time employment. The entire time of a
full-time superintendent shall be devoted to superin-
tendence in the school supervisory unit which employs
the superintendent. A superintendent who is employed
as a part-time superintendent shall perform the du-
ties agreed upon between the superintendent and the
employing school board, subject to approval by the

1 commissioner. A full-time superintendent may perform
2 educational service outside of the supervisory unit
3 with the approval of the commissioner and with the
4 consent of the school board.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT

6 This bill allows school units to employ a part-
7 time superintendent. For some smaller units, it is
8 not cost-effective to employ a full-time superintend-
9 ent and, because of their geographic location, im-
10 practical to join with other school units in employ-
11 ing a superintendent.

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
