Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 20-A MRSA \$1055, sub-\$8, as amended by PL 1983, c. 806, §12, is repealed and the following enacted in its place: Full-time employment. The entire time full-time superintendent shall be devoted to superintendence in the school supervisory unit which employs the superintendent. 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- This bill allows school units to employ a part-6 time superintendent.
