IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Extend the Reporting Deadline for the Teacher and Administrator Certification Study.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

8 Whereas, the teacher and administrator certifica-9 tion law is a vital component of Maine's recent edu-10 cational reform movement; and

11 Whereas, the reports on the teacher certification 12 pilot projects have just recently been presented to 13 the Legislature and the reports on the administrator 14 certification pilot projects are incomplete at this 15 time; and

1 Whereas, the Legislature requires additional time 2 to complete a thorough investigation of the certifi-3 cation law and the pilot projects in order to develop 4 appropriate recommendations; and

5 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 6 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 7 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 8 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-9 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 10 therefore,

11 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 12 follows:

PL 1983, c. 845, §5, 3rd 🛿 is amended to read:

14 The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education, shall conduct its 15 16 own review of the effect of this Act, and the pilot projects and the rule making accomplished to date by the state board; conduct at least one public hearing 17 18 19 on the pilot projects and state board's interim re-20 port₇; and shall make what recommendations it deems appropriate, including statutory changes, if any, 21 22 prior to April-1,-1987 May 1, 1987.

23 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited
24 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap 25 proved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

27 The purpose of this bill is to extend the dead-28 line for making recommendations on teacher and admin-29 istrator certification from April 1, 1987 to May 1, 30 1987.
