The latter document shall be registered with the Register of Deeds in Washington County and with the clerks of the Towns of Machias and Machiasport upon approval of this Act'

Some question was raised concerning the use of the term "wood post" in the bill. The committee has determined that these are treated wood posts embedded in concrete and is satisfied with the permanence of this type of marker.
