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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 421, L.D.
1301, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Boundary Between
the Towns of Machias and Machiasport."

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Amend the bill in the first paragraph in the last
3 lines (page 1, lines 15, 16 and 17 in L.D.) by
striking out the following: "this surveyor by a sur-
vey of the East Machias and Machiasport town line, at
an earlier time" and inserting in its place the fol-
lowing: 'Wayne A. Frye, registered land surveyor,
State of Maine, registration number 846, in his sur-
vey of the town line between East Machias, Machias
and Machiasport, May and June of 1980, Hanger 1,
Slide 139, and in his survey of the Machias and
Machiasport town line of March 4, 1985. The latter
document shall be registered with the Register of
Deeds in Washington County and with the clerks of the
Towns of Machias and Machiasport upon approval of
this Act'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment references the specific plan, in-
cluding the name of the registered surveyor, that
forms the basis for boundary information contained in
this bill. Some question was raised concerning the
use of the term "wood post" in the bill. The commit-
tee has determined that these are treated wood posts
embedded in concrete and is satisfied with the perma-
nence of this type of marker.
