AN ACT Concerning the Boundary Between the
Towns of Machias and Machiasport.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 The boundary line between the Town of Machias and
7 the Town of Machiasport. In Washington County, the
8 boundary line between the Town of Machias and the
9 Town of Machiasport shall be as described. The
10 boundary shall commence at the center of the channel
11 of the Machias River at a point that is north seven
12 degrees fifteen minutes East and 471 feet from a wood
13 post set in the ground at high water mark on the
14 southerly side of said river, said point being deter-
15 mined by this surveyor by a survey of the East
16 Machias and Machiasport town line, at an earlier
17 time.

1 Thence from said post south seven degrees fifteen
2 minutes west one thousand six hundred sixty six point
3 five feet, (S-07-15-W 1,666.5') to a granite monument
4 set in the ground on the northerly side of the road
5 that leads from Machias to Machiasport.

6 Thence continuing south seven degrees fifteen
7 minutes west four thousand eight hundred thirty four
8 point five feet, (S-07-15-W 4,834.5') to a one and
9 three quarter inch aluminum monument set in the
10 ground at a corner.

11 Thence north eighty two degrees forty five min-
12 utes west, one thousand two hundred fifty four point
13 eight feet, (N-82-45-W 1,254.8') to a one and three
14 quarter aluminum monument set in the ground at a cor-
15 ner.

16 Thence south seven degrees fifteen minutes west
17 one thousand six hundred thirty point five feet,
18 (S-07-15-W 1,630.5') to a one and three quarter inch
19 aluminum monument set in the ground at a corner.

20 Thence north eighty two degrees forty five min-
21 utes west five thousand five hundred eighty three
22 point six feet, (N-82-45-W, 5,583.6') to an aluminum
23 monument set in the ground at a corner.

24 Thence south four degrees forty five minutes west
25 six thousand six hundred thirty one point two feet
26 (S-04-45-W 6,631.2') to a granite monument set in the
27 ground on the north side of the Kennebec Cross Roads
28 so called.

29 Thence continuing south four degrees forty five
30 minutes west eight hundred seventy six point four
31 feet (S-04-45-W 876.4') to a wood post set in the
32 ground at high water mark of Little Kennebec Bay.

33 Meaning and intending to clarify and establish
34 the common Machias-Machiasport town line as estab-
35 lished by the Legislature in Private and Special Laws
36 1826, chapter 367.
