10	Amend the amendment by striking out all of sec-
11	tion 3 and inserting in its place the following:
12	'Sec. 3. Appointment. The commission shall be
13	comprised of 15 members as follows: Six members of
14	the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker
15	of the House and 3 members of the Senate appointed by
16	the President of the Senate with expertise in natural
17	resources, fisheries and wildlife and taxation; and 6
18	nonlegislative members, representing or having an in-
19	terest in areas within the scope of the study, to be
20	appointed by the Governor. The Commissioner of Con-
21	servation or his designee and the Commissioner of In-
22	land Fisheries and Wildlife or his designee also
23	shall serve as ex officio members of the commission.'
24	Further amend the amendment in section 4 in the
25	last 2 lines (page 2, lines 11 and 12 in amendment)
26	by striking out the following: "Joint Standing Com-
27	mittee on Natural Resources" and inserting in its
28	place the following: 'Second Regular Session of the
29	l13th Legislature'
