SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"  
to S.P. 427, L.D. 1307, Bill, "AN ACT to Enhance  
Public Access and Outdoor Recreation Opportunities."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

**'Sec. 3. Appointment.** The commission shall be comprised of 15 members as follows: Six members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House and 3 members of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate with expertise in natural resources, fisheries and wildlife and taxation; and 6 nonlegislative members, representing or having an interest in areas within the scope of the study, to be appointed by the Governor. The Commissioner of Conservation or his designee and the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife or his designee also shall serve as ex officio members of the commission.'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in the last 2 lines (page 2, lines 11 and 12 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources" and inserting in its place the following: 'Second Regular Session of the 113th Legislature'
