SENATE AMENDMENT " B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
8 to S.P. 427, L.D. 1307, Bill, "AN ACT to Enhance
9 Public Access and Outdoor Recreation Opportunities."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sec-
11 tion 3 and inserting in its place the following:

12

'Sec. 3. Appointment. The commission shall be
13 comprised of 15 members as follows: Six members of
14 the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker
15 of the House and 3 members of the Senate appointed by
16 the President of the Senate with expertise in natural
17 resources, fisheries and wildlife and taxation; and 6
18 nonlegislative members, representing or having an in-
19 terest in areas within the scope of the study, to be
20 jointly appointed by the Speaker of the House and the
21 President of the Senate. The Commissioner of Conser-
22 vation or his designee and the Commissioner of Inland
23 Fisheries and Wildlife or his designee also shall
24 serve as ex officio members of the commission.'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in the
26 last 2 lines (page 2, lines 11 and 12 in amendment)
27 by striking out the following: "Joint Standing Com-
28 mittee on Natural Resources" and inserting in its
29 place the following: 'Second Regular Session of the
30 113th Legislature'


