COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 427, L.D.  
1307, Bill, "AN ACT to Enhance Public Access and Out-  
door Recreation Opportunities."

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Amend the bill by striking out all of the title  
and inserting in its place the following:

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**'AN ACT Establishing the Maine Commission on Outdoor  
Recreation.'**

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Further amend the bill by striking out everything  
after the enacting clause and before the statement of  
fact and inserting in its place the following:

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**'Sec. 1. Commission established.** There is cre-  
ated the Maine Commission on Outdoor Recreation.

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**Sec. 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the commission  
is to examine the present outdoor recreation needs of  
the public and to determine whether current public  
policies properly address that need.

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**Sec. 3. Appointment.** The commission shall be  
comprised as follows: Six members of the House of  
Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House  
and 3 members of the Senate appointed by the Presi-  
dent of the Senate with expertise in natural re-  
sources, fisheries and wildlife and taxation; and 7  
members appointed by the Governor, one of whom shall  
be a representative of organized sportsman's groups,  
one of whom shall be a large industrial landowner  
presently engaged in exclusive recreational leasing  
of forest land, one of whom shall be a representative  
of organized forest landowners' groups, one of whom  
shall be a representative of sporting camp owners,  
one of whom shall be a representative of organized  
snowmobilers' groups, one of whom shall be a repre-
