#### STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide Required Matching Funds for Federal Disaster Assistance Funds Expected to be Available to the State.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, as a result of extensive spring flooding, significant portions of the State have been declared eligible for federal disaster assistance funds; and

Whereas, these funds are required to be matched by state and local contributions; and  $\begin{tabular}{ll} \end{tabular}$ 

1 2 3 4 0 5 6	Whereas, in order to ensure the receipt of these funds in as timely a manner as possible so that efforts to repair flood damage may be maximized, it is deemed to be in the overall best interests of the people of the State that required matching funds be provided from available state resources; and

Notwithstanding the language in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1513, the funds appropriated in this Act are intended to provide the State Government and local government shares of such funds as necessary to match federal disaster assistance funds approved for the State.
22 23 24	Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the Rainy Day Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
