STATE OF MAINE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN AN ACT to Amend Procedural Safeguards Regarding Juvenile Offenders. Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine follows: 15 MRSA §3301, sub-\$1-A is enacted to read: 1-A. Requirements at preliminary investigation. At a minimum, the preliminary investigation conducted by a juvenile intake worker shall include the following to ensure equitable treatment of juveniles:

Documented written attempts by the

worker to meet with the juvenile and his legal

custodian; and
