NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Amend Procedural Safeguards  
Regarding Juvenile Offenders.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
follows:

15 MRSA §3301, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

1-A. Requirements at preliminary investigation.  
At a minimum, the preliminary investigation conducted  
by a juvenile intake worker shall include the follow-  
ing to ensure equitable treatment of juveniles:

A. Documented written attempts by the intake  
worker to meet with the juvenile and his legal  
custodian; and
