AN ACT to Establish the First Week of June as Maine State Garden Week.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

3 4 5 6 7	Whereas, the National Council of State Garden Clubs has asked the Maine Federation of Garden Clubs to join with other states in seeking legislation to establish the first week of June as State Garden Week by June, 1987; and
8 9 10 11 12	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

17	§126. Maine State Garden Week
18 19 20 21 22	Maine State Garden Week shall be established on June 1st to June 8th of each year and the Governor shall annually issue a proclamation inviting and urging the people of the State to observe the week with appropriate celebration and activities.
23 24 25	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
26	STATEMENT OF FACT
27 28 29	The purpose of this bill is to establish on behalf of the Maine Federation of Garden Clubs, the first week of June as Maine State Garden Week.
