NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Enable Hunting for the Disabled.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

12 MRSA §7076, sub-§13 is enacted to read:

13. Disabled residents. Upon application, the
commissioner may authorize disabled residents of this
State to hunt from the roadside of certain public
ways, providing the applicant can furnish satisfactory
proof of a permanent and incapacitating disability
that prevents hunting from the field, but still possesses
the required physical and mental skills to hunt. The
commissioner may prescribe by rule: Use of special
vehicles and equipment; use of permits and public ways;
extent of assistance needed; the level of hunting skill
required and requirements for safety.
