STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD  
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

1 AN ACT to Provide Pension Rights to Morris G.  
2 Pilot.  
3

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
5 follows:

6 Sec. 1. Pension rights for Morris G. Pi-  
7 lot. Morris G. Pilot shall have the pension rights  
8 granted in this Act.

9 Sec. 2. Retirement pension. Notwithstanding the  
10 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 4, chapter 29, Morris  
11 G. Pilot, on reaching the age of 65, shall have the  
12 right to a pension equal to 35% of his average final  
13 compensation as a District Court Judge. "Average fi-  
14 nal compensation" is defined in the Maine Revised

1 Statutes, Title 4, section 1201, subsection 3. The  
2 pension shall be adjusted annually by a cost-  
3 of-living factor, as determined in the Maine Revised  
4 Statutes, Title 4, section 1358.

5 **Sec. 3. Survivors benefits.** On the death of  
6 Morris G. Pilot, his spouse Ann S. Pilot, if living,  
7 shall receive a pension equal to 35% of his average  
8 final compensation or his retirement allowance at the  
9 time of his death, whichever is greater. The pension  
10 shall be adjusted annually by a cost-of-living factor  
11 as determined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 4,  
12 section 1358.

13 **Sec. 4. Funding.** Benefits provided in this Act  
14 shall be funded solely by the State in the same man-  
15 ner as provided under the Maine Revised Statutes, Ti-  
16 tle 4, section 1403.

17 FISCAL NOTE

18 There will be a future cost starting in 1991.  
19 The pension will start at \$10,036.

20 STATEMENT OF FACT

21 The new draft changes the benefit to 35%, removes  
22 the daughter who is over 18 years of age and adds a  
23 fiscal note.
