1 Whereas, a deficit in the board's budget will 2 induce obligations for the Department of Professional 3 and Financial Regulation; and

Whereas, at the recommendation of Standing Committee on Audit and Program Review, the board has not mailed renewal notices for renewals due January 1987, pending passage of this Act; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; therefore,

14 it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 15 follows:

32 MRSA §7028, as repealed and replaced 16 17 by PL 1983, c. 812, §253, is repealed and the following enacted in its place: 18

#### §7028. Compensation and expenses

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Compensation of members shall be in accordance with Title 5, chapter 379, provided that expenses do not exceed the fees collected by the board. fees to be collected under this chapter are insufficient to pay the expenses provided by this section, the board members shall be entitled to a pro rata payment in any years in which the fees are insufficient.

32 MRSA §7056, as amended by PL 1985, c. Sec. 2. 29 736, §16, is further amended to read:

### §7056. Application; fees

Application for license as a licensed clinical, licensed master or licensed social worker shall be on form prescribed and furnished by the board. An application fee and an examination fee may be established by the board in amounts which are reasonable and necessary for their respective purposes. All fees shall accompany the application.

	The license feet for a licensed social worker shall be established by the board in an amount not to exceed \$50 $\frac{$70}{}$ .
4 5 6	The license fee for a licensed master social worker shall be established by the board in an amount not to exceed \$75 $\$110$ .
7 8 9	The license fee for a licensed clinical social worker shall be established by the board in an amount not to exceed $\$125$ $\$175$ .
10 11 12 13	Fees for initial and renewal licenses shall be set so that total fee receipts do not exceed the amount required to cover properly the expense of performing the duties imposed upon the board.
14 15 16	If the board denies the issuance of a license to any applicant, the application and examination fees shall be nonrefundable.

Biennial fees for renewal of license shall be set by the board in an amount not to exceed \$50 those amounts specified in section 7056 and shall be due and payable biennially on or before the first day of January. License renewal fees for certified social workers shall be the same as those for licensed master social workers. Every 2nd renewal shall be contingent upon evidence of participation in a continuing professional education course or program as approved by the board. A license may be renewed up to 90 days after the date of expiration upon payment of a late fee of \$10 in addition to the renewal fee. Any person who submits an application for renewal more than 90 days after the renewal date shall be subject to all requirements governing new applicants under this chapter, except that the board may in its discretion, giving due consideration to the protection of the public, waive examination if the renewal application is made within 2 years from the date of the expiration.

Prior to this fiscal year, social workers employed in hospitals, nursing homes or by the State were not required to be licensed. This exemption was removed a year ago and, in conjunction with this re-
