1 AN ACT to Hold Employees of Licensees
2 Criminally Liabile for Knowingly Selling Liquor

6 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
7 follows:

8 28 MRSA §1058, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1983, c.
9 14, is amended to read:

10 1. Offense. It is a violation of this section
11 for any person, other than a licensee ~~or his agent~~
12 ~~within the scope of his employment~~, to knowingly:

13 A. Procure, or in any way aid or assist in pro-
14 curing, furnish, give or deliver liquor for a mi-
15 nor or any intoxicated person; or

1 B. Allow any minor under his control, or on
2 premises under his control, to consume alcoholic
3 beverages.

4 STATEMENT OF FACT

5 This bill make it illegal for a clerk or employee
6 of a licensee to knowingly sell liquor to a minor.
