10 11	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:
12 13	<pre>'Sec. 1. 36 MRSA \$6162, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 726, \$7, is repealed.</pre>
14	Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §6162-A is enacted to read:
15	<pre>§6162-A. Eligibility; definitions; appeal</pre>
16 17	Individuals are eligible for this program if they meet the following conditions.
18 19 20	1. Age. For fiscal year 1987-88, individuals qualify under this program if they meet the age re- quirements under chapte: 901 and its successors.
21	2. Income. Incividuals representing single -
22 23	member households qualify for this program if their household income does not exceed \$6,600 in 1986 and,
24 25	as adjusted, in subsequent years. Individuals repre- senting households with 2 or more members qualify for
26	this program if their household income does not ex-
27 28	ceed \$8.500 in 1986 and, as adjusted, in subsequent years.
29	3. Residence. An individual must be a legal
30 31	resident of this State at the time the application is filed.
3 2	4. Limitation. An individual does not qualify
33 34	under this program if receiving state supplemental income benefits.

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1	5. Definitions. As used in this chapter, unless
2	the context clearly indicates otherwise, all terms
3	have the same meaning as in chapter 901 and its suc-
4	cessors.
5	6. Adjustment. The income limitations provided
6	in this section shall be adjusted annually in the
7	same manner as provided in chapter 901 and its suc-
8	cessors.
9	7. Appeals. The eligibility decision, made by
10	the State Tax Assessor or his designee, shall be fi-
11	nal, subject to appeal in accordance with the Maine
12	Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375.
13	STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment increases the eligibility income
level for multimember households under the Elderly
Low-cost Drug Program. Funding for this increase has
been provided in the Part II Budget.
