1 **Resolve, to Establish the Joint Select**
2 **Committee to Study the Benefits and Costs**
3 **Related to Permanent Impairment**
4 **Injuries under the Workers'**
5 **Compensation Act.**

7 **Established. Resolved:** That there is established
8 the Joint Select Committee to Study the Benefits and
9 Costs Related to Permanent Impairment Injuries under
10 the Workers' Compensation Act; and be it further

11 **Committee. Resolved:** That the committee shall
12 consist of 9 members, as follows: Five members of
13 the House of Representatives to be appointed by the
14 Speaker of the House and 4 members of the Senate to
15 be appointed by the President of the Senate. The
16 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House

1 shall be ex officio members of the committee. The
2 appointing authorities shall make the appointments
3 within 30 days following passage of this resolve and
4 shall notify the Legislative Council in writing of
5 their selections. The chairman of the Legislative
6 Council shall call the first meeting of the committee
7 and the committee shall select a chairman from among
8 its members; and be it further

9 **Findings. Resolved:** That the committee shall
10 present its findings, together with any necessary
11 recommended legislation, to the Second Regular Ses-
12 sion of the 113th Legislature; and be it further

13 **Compensation. Resolved:** That legislative mem-
14 bers of the committee shall receive the legislative
15 per diem as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes,
16 Title 3, section 2, for days of attendance at commit-
17 tee meetings. If the committee meets on a day when
18 the Legislature is in session, legislative members
19 shall receive only one legislative per diem on that
20 day, but may be reimbursed for all necessary expenses
21 upon application to the Executive Director of the
22 Legislative Council; and be it further

23 **Staff assistance. Resolved:** That the commission
24 may request staff assistance from the Legislative
25 Council. All agencies and departments of State Gov-
26 ernment shall cooperate with the committee and shall
27 expeditiously provide the committee with the informa-
28 tion and materials that it needs to carry out the
29 purposes of this resolve.

30 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

31 The purpose of this resolve is to establish the
32 Joint Select Committee to Study the Benefits and
33 Costs Related to Permanent Impairment Injuries under
34 the Workers' Compensation Act.

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
