

and thereafter neither the Town of Island Falls nor the inhabitants of Island Falls shall be responsible for obligations incurred prior to the time of annexation.

 Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall take effect for all purposes 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature and ratifies the approval by a majority of the legal voters of the Town of Island Falls at its town meeting held on March 16, 1987.
