4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows:

12 MRSA §7076, sub-§6, as amended by PL 1985, c. 369, §4, is further amended to read:

6. Armed Forces domiciled in Maine. A combination fishing and hunting license shall be issued upon payment of \$11 in 1985, \$13 in 1986 and \$15 in 1987 and thereafter, plus the issuing fee, to a Maine resident serviceman on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States who is permanently stationed outside of the State, his spouse and children.

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provided that he can show proof that his home of record is Maine. These persons shall be issued all other licenses or permits at resident fees. The license will be valid during the year of issue.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft clarifies the requirement for a serviceman stationed outside of Maine to purchase combination fishing and hunting licenses at a reduced rate.

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
