Amend the bill in section 6 in the 2nd paragraph in the last line (page 3, line 5 in L.D.) by adding after the word "commissioner" the following: 'except that the Executive Director of the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission shall serve at the pleasure of the commissioner and a majority of the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission'

Amend the bill in section 10 in paragraph M in the last line (page 4, line 7 in L.D.) by adding after the following: "nursery." the following: 'At least 60 days prior to offering any surplus property for sale under this paragraph, the director shall notify the Executive Director of the Legislative Council and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resources of his intent to sell the property.'

The purpose of this amendment is to clearly preserve the role of the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission in the hiring and firing of the commission's executive director. The amendment also adds a requirement for the Director of Forestry to notify the Legislature of the bureau's intent to sell surplus property at the state nursery.
