STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Strengthen the Laws Relating to
Food Safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

Sec. 1. 22 M.R.S.A. §2167, as enacted by PL 1979, c.
672, Pt. A, §54, is amended by adding at the end a
new paragraph to read:

Any person, firm or corporation who violates this
licensing requirement or any condition placed on any
such license commits a civil violation for which a
forfeiture of not more than \$1,000 may be adjudged
for each offense and, in addition, the commissioner
may suspend, revoke or refuse to renew any such li-
cense in accordance with Title 5, chapter 375, sub-
chapter V.
