8 9	§806-A. Reimbursement for private citizens by police departments
0	A person charged with a criminal offense may be
1	entitled to reimbursement from a police department
2	for reasonable costs incurred as a result of being
3	arrested by a police officer in the employ of that
4	department if there is a final judgment of not guilty
5	on all charges, and on motion of the defendant, the

1 2 3 4	judge presiding at the underlying criminal trial finds by clear and convincing evidence that the arresting officer arrested the defendant knowing he had no legal right to do so.
5 6 7 8 9 10 11	The presiding judge shall determine the extent of reimbursement, taking into account any contributory misconduct of the defendant. Any reimbursement ordered and paid shall be deducted from the amount of any judgment awarded in a civil action brought by the criminal defendant against a law enforcement officer or a state, county, municipality or other political unit based on the same facts.
13 14 15	Any claim for payment under this section must be made within 30 days of the entry of final judgment. STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to enable persons arrested maliciously and in bad faith to be reimbursed for the costs they incur in defending themselves in court.
