3	device which, upon insertion of money, tokens or any
4	other form of payment, dispenses cigarettes.
5	2. Violation. It is unlawful for any person,
6	firm or corporation to knowingly distribute or sell
7	cigarettes by the use of a vending machine in a loca-
8 9	tion other than a location that is generally super-
10	vised by an adult during the hours the machine is ac- cessible.

11	3. Penalty. Any person, firm or corporation, in
12	control of a facility in which a vending machine is
13	located, who violates this section commits a civil
14	violation for which a forfeiture of not less than
15	\$100 nor more than \$500 may be adjudged or for which

17	for a period of not more than 6 months, from having a
