14 15	Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:
16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26	'Sec. 3. Transition. No employer may commence a substance abuse testing program after the effective date of this Act until January 1, 1988. All workplace substance abuse testing programs in existence on the effective date of this Act shall stop any substance abuse testing of employees, except that any workplace substance abuse testing program that existed on January 1, 1987, may continue operation until January 1, 1988. All workplace substance abuse testing programs must comply fully with this Act and rules adopted under this Act on January 1, 1988.'
27 28	Further amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency clause.

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	This amendment removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause from the bill and amends the transition clause to ensure that any workplace substance abuse testing program that was or may be hastily-implemented in consideration of this legislation will terminate operation on the effective date of this bill. Testing programs in existence on January 1, 1987, may continue operation until January 1, 1988, as under the original bill. Only those programs initiated after January 1, 1987, must stop operation.
