Amend the Bill in subsection 2 by striking out
all of the last 5 lines (page 2, lines 1 to 5 in
L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:
'statistics, ~~shall--be--guilty--of--a--misdemeanor,--and~~
~~upon--conviction--shall--be--fined--not--less--than--\$25--nor~~
~~more--than--\$100~~ on first offense commits a Class E
crime and on 2nd and subsequent offenses commits a
Class D crime.'
