7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 462, L.D. 8 1419, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Cancer Prevention 9 and Control Advisory Committee."

10 Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all 11 of the last paragraph and inserting in its place the 12 following:

'The committee shall be composed of not less than 13 14 members. One half of the members shall be ap-14 pointed by the Governor and 1/2 of the members shall be appointed jointly by the President of the Senate 15 16 and the Speaker of the House. Members shall serve for 3-year terms, except that initially 5 shall be appointed for 3 years 5 for 3 years 5 for 3 years 17 18 19 appointed for 3 years, 5 for 2 years and 4 for one year. Members shall include individuals with train-20 ing and experience in the following fields: 21 Medi-22 cine, M.D. or D.O.; oncology; medical and biological sciences; hospital administration; nursing; medical 23 24 records administration; hospital tumor registry operations; health promotion and education; epidemiology; 25 and biometry. The 5 members initially appointed for 26 and blometry. The 5 members initially appointed for terms of 3 years and 2 of the members appointed for one year shall be appointed by the Governor. The 5 members initially appointed for a term of 2 years and 2 of the members appointed for one year shall be ap-pointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House. Members shall be compen-27 28 29 30 31 32 33 sated according to Title 5, chapter 379. The commit-34 tee shall meet at least once annually in Augusta.'
