AN ACT to Prohibit Candidates from Receiving,

2 3	Witnessing or Accepting Absentee Ballots.
4 5	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
6	21-A MRSA §791, sub-§3 is enacted to read:
7	3. Candidate; violation. Notwithstanding this
8	subchapter, any candidate who applies for, receives,
9	accepts or witnesses absentee ballots commits a Class
.0	D crime.

This bill enacts a new subsection prohibiting candidates from receiving, witnessing or accepting absentee ballots. This penalty section applies to any action taken by a candidate in connection with an absentee ballot.
