4 5	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
6	23 MRSA §1205 is enacted to read:
7	§1205. Historic district
8 9 .0 .1	Upon request from a municipality, suitable markers and signs shall be placed by the department on state highways and the interstate system, designating the location of historic districts.
.2 3	The cost to the State shall be borne by the municipality making the request.

This bill allows the Department of Transportation to erect signs pointing out to the motorist the location of historic districts in Maine.
