NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Create a Maine National Historic  
District Sign Program.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
follows:

23 MRSA §1205 is enacted to read:

§1205. Historic district

Upon request from a municipality, suitable mark-  
ers and signs shall be placed by the department on  
state highways and the interstate system, designating  
the location of historic districts.

The cost to the State shall be borne by the mu-  
nicipality making the request.
