11 Amend the Bill in Part A, in section 4, in that 12 part designated "<u>§5001</u>." in subsection 4, in the 4th 13 line (page 5, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the 14 following: "disclosure" the following: 'and the dis-15 closure is otherwise permitted pursuant to section 16 4008'

Further amend the Bill in Part A, in section 4, in that part designated "<u>§5001.</u>" in subsection 4, in the 5th line (page 5, line 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "idenity" and inserting in its place the following: 'identity'

22 Further amend the Bill in Part B by inserting be-23 fore section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §4008, sub-§2, ¶A, as enacted
by PL 1979, c. 733, §18, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

27	A. An agency or person investigating or partici-
28	pating on a team investigating a report of child
29	abuse or neglect when the investigation or par-
30	ticipation is authorized by law or by an agree-
31	ment with the department;'

32 Further amend the Bill in Part B, in section 1, 33 in that part designated "<u>§5005.</u>" in subsection 2, in 34 the 5th and 6th lines (page 7, lines 27 and 28 in 35 L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>charged with</u> 36 the duty"

1 Further amend the Bill in Part B by renumbering 2 the sections to read consecutively. 3 Further amend the Bill in Part C by striking out all of the last 12 lines (page 11, lines 19 to 30 in 4 L.D.) and inserting in their place the following: 5 6 7 'TOTAL APPROPRIATION \$174,022 \$178,496' Further amend the Bill in the emergency clause in the 3rd line (page 11, line 33 in L.D.) by inserting 8 9 after the following: "1987" the following: ', except 10 11 for Part B, section 3, which shall take effect on Ju-12 ly 1, 1988' STATEMENT OF FACT 13 14 This amendment ensures that the confidentiality provisions in current law regarding child welfare 15 records apply to the ombudsman and relevant profes-16 sionals working with the out-of-home abuse and ne-17 glect investigating team, delays consolidation of the 18 19 general licensing functions within the Bureau of So-20 cial Services until July 1, 1988, and deletes the recommendation providing in-house computerization to 21 the Division of Certification. 22
